



Launch of Climate Friendly Food

Climate Friendly Food is engaging farmers and growers across the UK in reducing their carbon emissions and encouraging consumers to reduce their food carbon footprint. Carbon emissions from the food chain make up around 30% of the UK's total carbon emissions. The UK is legally committed to reducing its carbon emissions by 80% by 2050, and it can't do so without huge cuts from the food sector.

To celebrate the launch, Climate Friendly Food have organised a week-long series of events. Starting at Dartington in Devon, Mukti Mitchell and Jonathan Smith will cycle 130 miles over 4 days to Bristol, stopping at organic farms on the way to Bristol.

Climate Friendly Food is committed to minimising its carbon footprint, so we're using sustainable travel to promote low carbon food. We will also be eating climate friendly food as we attach great importance to putting principles in to practice.
